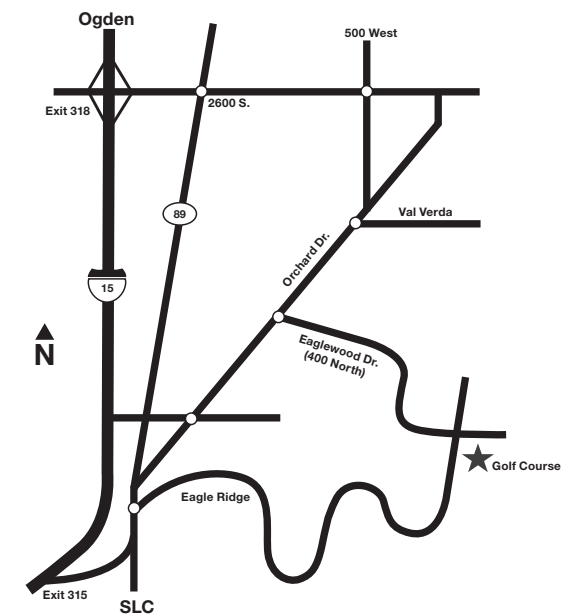

**From the South:**

Travel on I-15 Northbound to Exit 312. Take highway 89 North to the first stop-light (Eagle Ridge Drive). Turn right and stay in the right-hand lane and follow Eagle Ridge Drive approximately 2 miles until you arrive at Eaglewood Golf Course.

**From the North:**

Traveling on I-15 Southbound, take Exit 314 (North Salt Lake Center Street). Turn left (East) until you hit HWY 89. Turn right. Follow 89 to next stop-light (Eagle Ridge Drive), turn left and stay in right-hand lane. Follow Eagle Ridge Drive up the hill approximately 2 miles to Eaglewood Golf Course.
